

Salivary Gland Cancer UK Bursary Scheme

SGCUK administers a Bursary Fund for assistance in attending charity events in person. The aim of the Bursary Fund is to eliminate the financial difficulties some may face as a result of in-person attendance of the charity event. It offers financial support to assist patients and their carers to be actively participating in SGCUK in-person events.

- 1) Is a bursary always available for event attendance? Yes.
- 2) Who funds the bursary? Bursaries are funded in two ways:
 - 1. Charity bursary
 Bursary is funded directly by the charity
 - 2. Sponsor bursary
 Bursary is funded by another organisation partnering with the charity
- 3) Who is eligible to receive the available bursaries? Bursaries are available to anyone on income support/disability living allowance and/or in a vulnerable situation (as defined below), subject to charity finances:
- Receiving Income Support or Universal Credit because they are financially supporting themselves or financially supporting themselves and someone who is dependent on them and living with them, such as a child or partner.
- Receiving Disability Living Allowance or Personal Independence Payments in their own right as well as Employment Support Allowance or Universal Credit in their own right.

Bursaries may be available to others subject to the discretion of the Trustees.

- 4) How much is the bursary and what expenses does it cover? The bursary covers reasonable travel expenses per person attending an in-person event (subject to charity finances).
- 5) Is there a limit to the number of bursaries that can be applied for? No. Bursaries will be available to those who need them for each in-person event the charity hosts.
- 6) How do I apply?
