- 900 cases per year in the UK (approx.)
- 50% in major salivary glands in head & neck
- 25% in minor salivary gland in head & neck
- 25% in non-head & neck e.g. vulva
- No risk profile
- · Poorly understood biologies
- · No effective drug therapies
- Poor prognoses
- Research decades behind other cancers
